## PREFACE

The Veterans' Graves Registration Project is a state-wide project in the Research and Records Section, Professional and Service Division, Work Projects Administration. It was organized by, and has operated under the sponsorship of the Military Department of the State of Florida and the co-sponsorship of the American Legion, Department of Florida.

We have attempted to prepare a comprehensive record of all graves of honorably discharged veterans of the United States (including Confederate Veterans) that may be found in Florida. The record compiled consists of a card giving all available data and their sources, concerning the service record and burial place of each veteran whose grave can be located, and plats of cemeteries in which such graves are to be found. Cards and plats are filed as permanent records in the office of the Adjutant General in the State Arsenal, St. Augustine, Florida.

The project wishes to record here its particular indebtedness to the Adjutant General and his staff for the invaluable assistance they have rendered throughout the survey. Service and patriotic organizations whose cooperation is gratefully acknowledged are The American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Disabled American Veterans of the World War, United Spanish War Veterans, United Daughters of the Confederacy, United Sons of the Confederacy, Daughters of the American Revolution, Sons of the American Revolution, The American Red Cross and local units of the Florida National Guard.

BRANDY CREEK CEMETERY

SECTION 37, TOWNSHIP 1, S., RANGE 23, E.

From the City of Jacksonville, go out State Road #1 (U. S. Highway #90) and go 2 miles beyond Baldwin, turn right on River Road and go 5 miles to church and cemetery on left.

ALBRITTON CEMETERY

SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 1, N., RANGE 25, E.

From Jacksonville, go out U. S. Highway #1 passing Dinsmore and just beyond Duval and Nassau County line (indicated by a white post), turn right on dirt road until you reach the home of L. R. Booth. At this house ask for directions on how to reach cemetery.

BOSQUE BELLO CEMETERY

SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 3, N., RANGE 28, E.

At the intersection of 8th Street and Atlantic Avenue in the city of Fernandina, go west on Atlantic Avenue to 14th Street. Turn left on 14th Street and proceed 2 miles. Cemetery lies on left.
